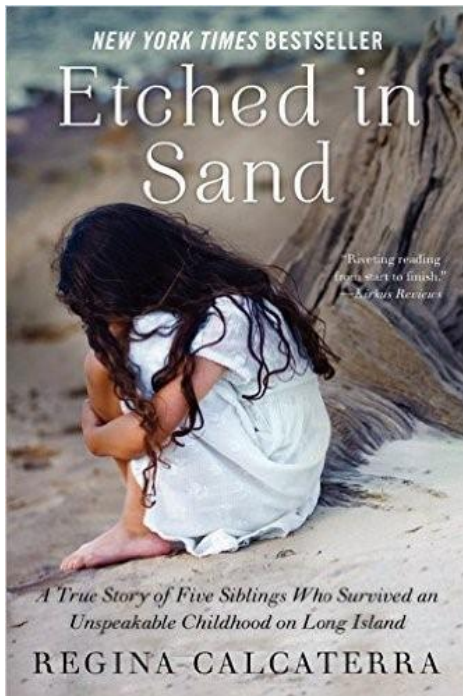




## BOOK CLUB
