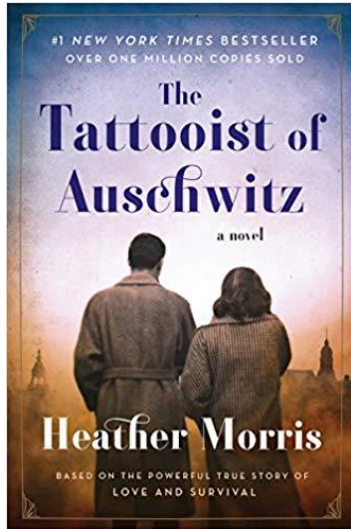




BOOK CLUB
