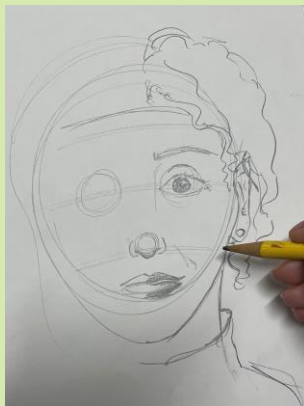

Relax, unwind, and enjoy yourself in this virtual art program where you'll learn how to draw human faces.

Start with basic shapes and proportions, then finish with details and textures. Special attention will be paid to drawing trickier features like eyes and noses. Explore a variety of mark-making techniques to capture different facial expressions. Experiment with shading techniques such as blending and smudging.

Appropriate for all skill levels from beginners to more advanced.

Materials needed are simply pencil and paper, but participants may use other drawing materials if they wish. The instructor will show how to draw using pencil, pen, marker, and color pencils.

The instructor from *The Art Effect*, a community-based, multi-arts educational center, will guide you through the creative process in an inclusive, relaxing manner.
